Summer School

REGISTRATION: Friday, June 12, 10:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.

LATE REGISTRATION: Monday, June 15 (\$25.00 late fee) 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.

ATTENDANCE: Students must attend all 20 days to receive credit. Please do not ask for days off for trips. Medical excuses will be honored if the student makes up all missed work at home.

DATES: Monday, June 15 – July 13
(No school on July 2 and July 3)
Classes meet Monday through Friday

FEES: **\$250** for one class; **\$350** for two classes
CASHIERS CHECK OR MONEY ORDER ONLY
No cash or personal checks will be accepted.

LATE REGISTRATION: \$25
Out-of-District fee - \$300/course; \$400 for two courses
Out-of-State fee: \$350/course; \$450 for two courses

GRADE REPORTS: Reports will be sent to parents weekly.
Final grades will be sent to the student's home school.

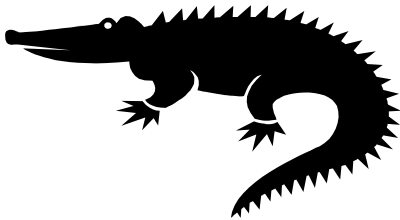
