

## Gold Star for Wagener-Salley JROTC Program

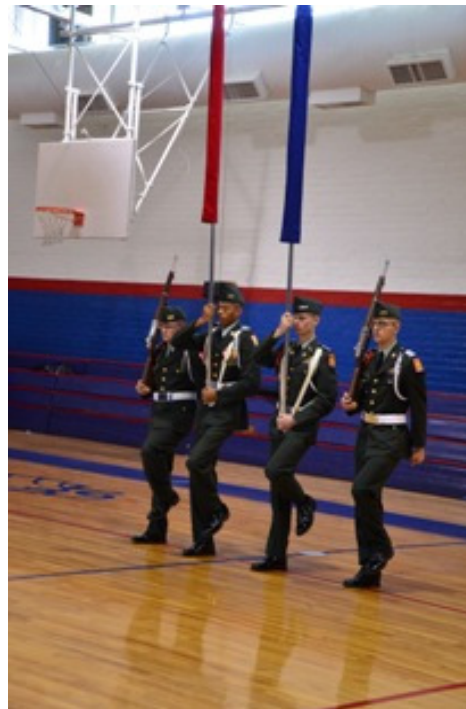
The Wagener-Salley High School JROTC Battalion earned their gold star during the Cadet Formal Inspection Evaluation on February 28, 2011. John Sovine and Buck Jenkins, from the Fourth JROTC Brigade located at Fort Bragg, North Carolina conducted the evaluation.

The War Eagle Battalion earned a 96.7 percent rating during the evaluation. The evaluators assessed all areas associated with the cadets running the program. These areas included a formal cadet staff briefing by the cadets, the cadets' knowledge of the JROTC curriculum, and an in-ranks inspection conducted by Army recruiters from the Aiken County Recruiting Office. The drill team and Color Guard conducted almost flawless drill and Color Guard routines. In addition to doing an outstanding job during the formal briefing, cadets on the battalion staff earned 158 points out of 160 points during the staff areas assessment. .

Cadet Command requires that a JROTC unit be assessed every three years for a unit to remain in good standing. The results of the evaluation were from the hard work and commitment of the cadets to be the best.
